The Certificate III in Mine Emergency Response and Rescue offered by Fire and Safety Australia is designed for individuals who wish to participate as part of a mine rescue emergency response team in an underground or open cut metalliferous mine.

Upon successful completion of this course, participants will gain skills and knowledge in:

- Mines rescue techniques and procedures
- Preparing and using rescue equipment
- Responding to mine incidents and emergencies
- Conducting Basic Fire Fighting Operation
- Responding to Mines Emergency such as Vertical or Confined Space Rescue
- Conducting Road Crash Rescue
- Risk management
- Safe work practices
- Operating in open circuit breathing apparatus
